

SUMMARY OF PROPOSED UNIVERSITY REGULATION AMENDMENT

FSU-2.009 Parking and Traffic Regulations

Note: This proposal does not change or impose any new fees for basic student parking which is not currently charged.

The proposed amendment would create new voluntary parking category to designate certain underused parking spaces in several areas as student reserved. Permits would be available for sale to park in such spaces on voluntary basis. This optional enhanced parking opportunity would be available at the proposed rate of \$325 for Academic year (Aug 15th thru April 30th) and \$415 for Annual (Aug 15 – Aug 14 following). The current regular student parking privileges which are not separately charged and current penalties would not be change. As this is currently underused space, the general student parking availability should not be adversely affected.

Use of Funds

The funds will be used to help offset operating expenses of parking including staffing, equipment, supplies, repair and maintenance)
